

IoBM crowned as Pakistan Champion of CIMA GBC Pakistan 2010

Institute of Business Management (IoBM) team “The Marks”, won the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA) Global Business Challenge 2010 Finals held on 15th May 2010 at Karachi. The Teams that participated in the Pakistan Finals included two teams from Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS) and two teams from IoBM.

“The Marks” comprised Team Leader Tajdar Ahmed Hashmi, Zaid imad, Sana Waqar and Hayat Omer Malik and was mentored by Ms Shazia Farooq (CFA and Faculty Member Finance IoBM).
