

**1. Students Exchange:**

- 1.1. Up to five students may be sent to the Partner University in each semester for one semester, (usually a semester is of four and a half months). An academic year has three semesters beginning in September to December, January to May and a Summer Semester from June to August.
- 1.2. The Host University shall exempt Exchange Students from tuition fee and provided them free boarding and lodging or facilitate in getting reasonable accommodation paid for by the students.
- 1.3. The Exchange Students may select up to five courses from the courses offered by the Host University during a semester, the credits / grades of which shall be transferred to the International Office of the Partner University through official transcript.

**2. Faculty Exchange:**

Faculty for specified disciplines may be exchanged for one or more semesters. The Faculty will be paid tax free salary in dollars as agreed between the two Universities. The faculty will be provided return airfare and free boarding and lodging on campus. If the faculty comes for more than a year, return air fare and boarding and lodging will also be provided to the spouse. The spouse can also be engaged at the University at agreed remuneration if the spouse has the required skills.

**3. Joint Research, Consultancy and Training Programs:**

The Researchers, Consultants and Training and Development Experts of the Partner Universities, when engaged in a Joint Project/ Assignment/ Program, shall be provided free boarding and lodging by the host University and provided fee as agreed between the Partner Universities. International travel cost of the concerned will be borne by the Home University, unless paid by the Project/ Assignment/ Program.

**4. Participation in International Funding Programs and Projects:**

The Partner Universities may participate jointly to avail International Funding Programs and apply for the International Projects on agreed terms and conditions.

**5. Others:**

The Partner Universities may participate in and cooperate for any other mutually beneficial activity/s on terms and conditions mutually agreed by the Managements of the two Universities.
