

CO-OPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
GUILIN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (GUT)
AND
INSTITUTE OF BUSINESS MANAGEMENT (IoBM)

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Guilin University of Technology (GUT), represented by Dr. ZHANG Xuehong, and Institute of Business Management (IoBM) represented by Mr. Shahjehan S. Karim, (hereinafter referred to as Parties) hereby agree to establish the following co-operation agreement for the purpose of promoting and expanding international development, understanding and friendship by stimulating and supporting educational, scientific, professional and cultural activities.

II. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

2. The Parties agree to carry out cooperatively the following activities:
- 2.1. joint and collaborative research;
 - 2.2. to develop joint degree programmes or other post-graduate activities;
 - 2.3. to organize joint conferences, seminars, courses for qualification, summer schools, and cognitive excursions by providing access to the information facilities of both Parties;
 - 2.4. mobility of academic and administrative staff members;
 - 2.5. mobility of graduate, undergraduate, and doctoral students, according to a plan which shall specify the number of students, temporary enrolment procedures and financial conditions, the possible grants, the guarantee of allocation, transfer and the recognition of academic credits;
 - 2.6. to co-operate in the further qualification improvement of lecturers of the Parties;
 - 2.7. exchange of information, materials and research publications in those fields which are of interest to both Parties;
 - 2.8. to publish articles in respective academic journals of each Party;
 - 2.9. to jointly take part in European Union funded programs including Erasmus Mundus and other international projects.

III. CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT IMPLEMENTATION

3. The co-operation between the Parties shall be implemented on the principle of parity.
4. Concerning the exchange of students, academic and administrative staff, the Parties agree to assist visiting persons to find accommodation and to become integrated in the social environment of the host country.
5. The co-operation agreement can be supplemented by annexes in order to implement certain joint activities.

IV. VALIDITY AND TERMINATION OF THE AGREEMENT

6. This agreement shall be in force from the day it is signed and is valid for five years. It may be automatically renewed for five years more on the basis of a general of the agreement.


7. The agreement may be terminated by either Party upon a three-month written notice to the other Party.

6. This agreement shall be in force from the day it is signed and will be valid for five years. It shall be automatically renewed for five more years unless intimation given otherwise by either Party.



4. Concerning the exchange of Students, Faculty, Academic and Administrative staff, the Parties agrees to waive fees and provide/ facilitate in getting accommodation and to become integrated in the social environment of the host Country.
5. The Academic Co-operation Agreement can be supplemented by annexure/s to specify operational mechanism and facilitate implementation thereof.
