

Policy for Student Extra-Curricular and Co-Curricular activities

The objective of promoting Student Societies and student led Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities is to fulfill IoBM's Vision and goals as given in the catalog: It is a part of the vision of IoBM to impart "skills, confidence, and values to its students thereby enabling them to become successful professionals globally". Each society is headed by a faculty advisor who is a senior member of the faculty or management and a team of students' office bearers. These societies are diverse in their activities. Seminars & workshops are organized where they invite well known personalities from business, government and corporate world. This provides them with an opportunity to exchange ideas and opinions with market leaders.

Our students participate in various events organized by other universities / institutes locally, as well as, internationally and have won laurels for their Institute. Community interactive is also encouraged and is a feature of many of these societies. For example, every year in the month of Ramdan donations in cash and kind are collected and, along with the Management's major contribution, distributed to the needy in various hospitals of the city.
