CRITERIA : The students have completed all course requirements and attained a CGPA of at least 3.0 in their program.

Bi-Major: Students who have done their majors in two subjects (i.e. Specialized course and another course (HRM/ Marketing/ Finance/LSCM) will appear in both the major subjects of 1 ½ hour each.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- The comprehensive examination is of three (3) hours duration.
- It is mandatory to pass Comprehensive Examination for obtaining the Official Transcript and MBA Degree.
- Students are allowed two attempts maximum to pass the comprehensive examination. A third attempt may be availed subject to Dean's approval only.
- The course outlines are available in the examination section for preparation of Comprehensive Exam.

- **Your eligibility to appear in the comprehensive examination will be checked and informed via email sent to your student email ID by Saturday, July 04, 2026.**
- You will receive acknowledgement right after the submission of the online registration form and no further acknowledgement is required. **(The email regarding confirmation of eligibility before 04th July will not be responded).**
